Katie Fisher, Science Editor



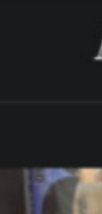

Fisher is excited for another great semester at *The Collegian* and the learning opportunities born from the fantastic journalism it produces.

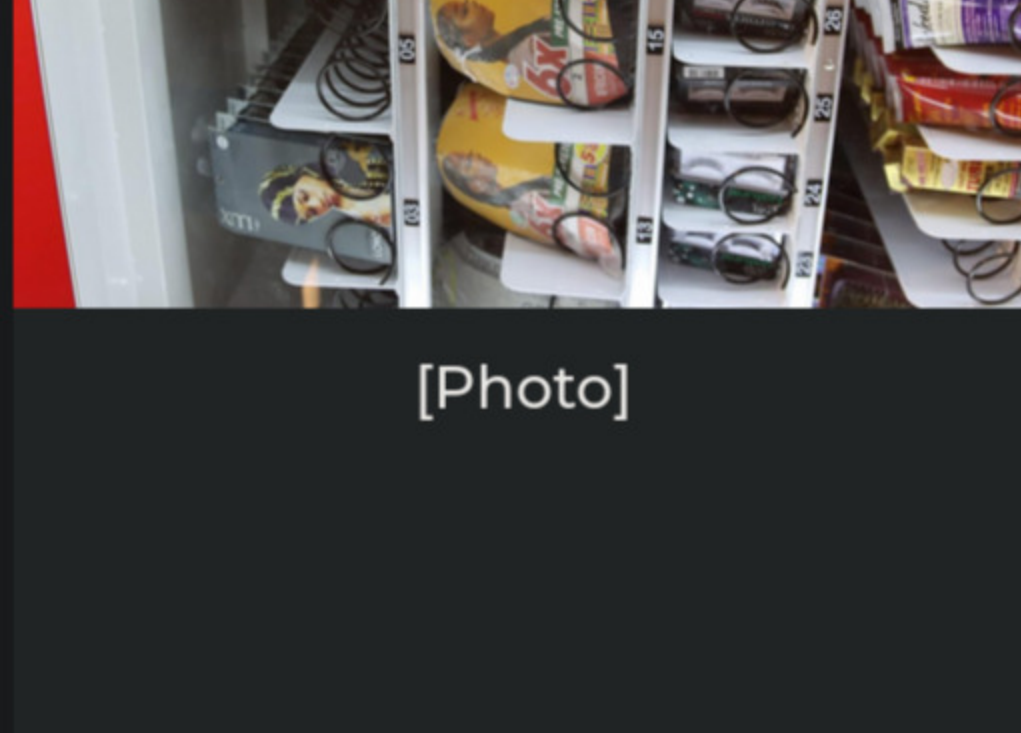
